

Medical conditions and Action Plans

Asthma

If your child has Asthma, please let us know on your child's enrolment form.

Prior to the Family-Teacher Meeting, you must obtain an **Asthma Action Plan** from your child's doctor. **Please bring the Action Plan, along with any reliever medication specified on the plan and a spacer, to the Family-Teacher Meeting.**

The medication and spacer will be held at the kinder for the duration of your child's enrolment. Should it near expiry, your child's teacher will let you know so you can replace it.

Your child's teacher will also liaise with you to write an **Asthma Risk Minimisation Plan** for your child.

Please ensure you always communicate any changes to your child's diagnosis or medication to their teacher.

Anaphylaxis and Allergies

If your child has been diagnosed as at risk of anaphylaxis or has allergies requiring medication, you must obtain the appropriate **ASCIA Action Plan** from your child's doctor.

Please bring the Action Plan (unless previously provided) and any medication specified on the plan, including an EPIPEN, to the Family-Teacher Meeting.

The medication will be stored at the kinder for the duration of your child's enrolment. Should it near expiry, your child's teacher will let you know so you can replace it.

Your child's teacher will also liaise with you to write an **Anaphylaxis Risk Minimisation Plan** for your child.

Other medical conditions that may require action plans include diabetes and eczema. Please always discuss your child's medical condition(s) with their teaching team.

ACTION PLANS:

* Must be brought to the Family-Teacher Meeting (unless provided prior), along with any medication specified in the Plan.

* Must be in date, easy to read and signed by your child's Doctor.

IMPORTANT:

* Action Plans that do not meet regulations will be returned for completion by your child's doctor.

* Children CANNOT attend kindergarten without the appropriate action plan and specified medication (including a spacer where required).
